

Sand Creek Raiders - Covid-19 Recommendations

Social Distancing -

All participants must be at least 6 feet apart from other shooters at all times (excluding TO), even in the parking lot. Face coverings/cloth masks/wild rags are highly recommended to be worn. If you are not feeling well then stay home. If you are not comfortable being around others then stay home. If you cannot abide by these guidelines then stay home. No hand shaking, hugging, sneezing, hacking, spitting, coughing, or scratching allowed. If you have hand sanitizer or wipes to clean your hands please bring them with you. Respect yourself and others.

Be safe, be aware and have fun. Someday this virus will be under control and we can get back to our normal shooting. Until then we need to adjust our lives a little and help one another to stay safe

Check-in -

Two people will be in charge of check-in and will be required to wear a face covering. Only one shooter may check in at a time, others waiting please space yourself accordingly. Arrive early to allow extra time for check-in. Please print out the waivers if possible and have them ready at check in or at least bring your own pen. Please bring correct change or a check made out to Sand Creek Raiders \$15. per shooter. All fees can be deposited in a can at the check-in table, no change will be given, any overage will be considered a donation. Since we are only allowed 10 shooters per posse per bay all registered shooters will be divided per posse not to exceed the 10. We have 6 bays which will limit the # of shooters to 60 per match. First come first served. If you would like to reserve spot on a posse please contact us by phone or email.

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Score Keeper and Timer Operator –

There will be one designated score keeper per posse, if there is a husband and wife then the other person will score while spouse is shooting.

There will be 2 timers and 2 TO's per posse. They will be given their own timer, sanitized and in a bag. The TO is only to use the timer assigned and no one else handles that timer throughout the match. All TO's will be required to wear a face covering since they will be unable to keep 6 feet of safe distancing at all times. All guns are to be handled by shooters only.

Match –

There will be no more than 2 shooters at the loading table keeping safe distance apart. All shooters will be required to work and some will be doing double duty. Scorekeeper can also watch the unloading table or spot. Spotters can also pickup spent brass. Each posse will be given 2 brass pickup tools, these will be sanitized and are not to be shared. Spent brass should be picked up by a brass pickup tool only, no picking brass by hand. If you own a brass pickup tool please bring your own. All knock down targets should be reset by ropes, feet, or chains. If you have gloves please use them to set up targets. Visitors must stay out of the bay area and practice social distancing while attending and they are required to wear a mask, eye and hearing protection.

Hydration –

Please bring your own preferred method of hydration. No water will be provided. No alcohol is allowed until after you have completed the match. It is getting warmer thus stay hydrated.

Set-up and tear down –

We will be setting up on Sunday at 7:30am, all help will be appreciated. Please bring gloves. Registration opens at 8:30am. Our match will begin at 9:30am. All help will be appreciated to assist with tear down. Please bring gloves.
